

Planning the Time during Children's Workshops

Factors that help to increase learning during a workshop:

- active listening means listening with a purpose: for directions, explanations, replying to questions, etc. The time factor: must be short periods to keep concentration. However, "listening only" can result in low retention rates.
- involvement of the learners will result in the highest levels of retention and interest
- arrange the time from large group activity to small group activity, to large group activity, etc. (see diagram below)
